Household Hazardous Waste

Household Hazardous Waste is considered to be used or leftover contents of consumer products that contain chemicals that can be characterized as:

**Toxic
Flammable
Corrosive**

Chemically reactive household hazardous waste:

- **Should be segregated at curbside from other types of debris**
- **Requires environmentally proper disposal at an appropriate site**
- **May be required to be removed by EPA**

Examples of Household Hazardous waste are:

- **Household cleaning products**
- **Latex and oil base paints**
- **Cleaning solvents**
- **Gasoline**
- **Oils**
- **Swimming pool chemicals**
- **Pesticides**
- **Propane gas cylinders**

Please put all HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE into a separate pile at the curb.
