

SCHOHARIE COUNTY EMERGENCY INFORMATION TO RESIDENTS

Be Prepared in Case of Flooding

September 7, 2011 8:25 am

The National Weather Service is predicting heavy rain all day turning to showers overnight. The ground remains saturated and increased run off into the waterways is expected.

All residence in low lying areas and near water ways are highly encouraged to monitor changing weather conditions and flooding in their areas and be prepared to follow local emergency procedures.

Water flow amounts are being anticipated based on the weather forecasting models. Monitoring equipment is being checked at regular intervals and any significant change will be reported to the County Emergency Operation Center. Cubic Feet Second (CFS) 10,000 at Gilboa Dam is expected by 9:00 am this morning. Localized flooding is expected in lower lying areas over the next few hours. Information will be shared immediately as these numbers change regularly
