**Fall/Winter 2015-2016 Training Courses**

**Pre-register for all classes with the Office of Emergency Services.**

There will be an **Intermediate ICS for Expanding Incidents (I-300)** course held in the basement classroom of the Schoharie County Office Building beginning on Tuesday January 5th, and continuing Tuesday January 12th, 19th and February 2nd, 9th, 16th from 6:30 pm - 10:30 pm each night. Pre-requisite is I-200. Please make sure you can provide I-200 certificate.

There will be a **Strategy and Tactics for Initial Company Operations** course held at the Jefferson Fire Station beginning on Wednesday January 6 at 6:00 PM and continuing for the next 3 Wednesdays Jan. 13, 20, 27. Pre-Requisite is Firefighter 1.

There will be a **Principles of Building Construction—Combustible** course beginning on Tuesday January 12th at the Gallupville Fire Station at 7:00 PM and continuing on January 14, 19, and 21.

There will be an **8 Hour OSHA Refresher** course being held at the Gallupville Fire Station on Monday January 18th beginning at 6:30 pm

There will be an **8 Hour OSHA Refresher** course held at the Middleburgh Fire Station on Monday February 1st at 6:30 PM and continuing on Monday February 8th at 6:30 PM.

A **Haz Mat Incident Command** course will be held at the Office of Emergency Services beginning on Tuesday February 2nd at 6:30 PM and will continue on February 3rd, 9th, 10th, 16th, & 18th. **\*\*Note that this course is a requirement of ANY officer that may be in command of any Haz Mat incident.\*\***

There will be an **Incident Safety Officer** course held at the Fire Training Center beginning on Tuesday February 16th at 7:00 PM and continuing on February 18th, 22nd, 24th and March 1st. Pre-Requisite is **Firefighter 1**.

There will be an **On Scene Rehabilitation for Emergency Operation** course held at the Carlisle Fire Station beginning on Tuesday February 16th at 7:00 PM and continuing on February 18th, 23rd, and 25th.

A **Haz Mat Decontamination** course will be held at the Office of Emergency Services on Thursday February 25th beginning at 6:30 PM

There will be a **Pump Operator** course held at the Esperance Fire Station beginning on Tuesday March 15th at 7:00 PM and continuing on March 17th, 19th, 22nd 24th, and 26th. Saturday classes will begin at 8:00 AM.

A **Firefighter 1** course will be held in the spring. Orientation session will be March 8th at the Cobleskill Fire Station and class sessions will begin approximately one month after. Remaining classes will be held at the Fire Training Center. **We are awaiting approval from OFPC on the proposed class dates. As soon as we receive approval we will update this schedule.** All Saturday classes will begin at 8:00 AM. Week night classes vary from 6:30 to 7:00. **Pre-registration for this class must be done through the Chief of the department only.**
