
DAILY SITUATION REPORT – December 29, 2016

Current Activation Status: Level 4 – Steady State

**Current Incidents:**

- NWS has issued a Winter Weather Advisory in effect from 7am this morning to 7am Friday. Snow will develop this morning and continue into this evening, tapering off tonight. Expected snowfall totals between 4”-8” with greater amounts north of the Capital District. Impacts will be hazardous driving conditions due to snow covered roads and reduced visibility.
- NWS has issued a Hazardous Weather Outlook for our area. Another storm system has the potential to produce freezing rain Monday afternoon through Tuesday morning. We will keep you updated as information becomes available. Please also stay tuned to local weather stations.
- 11/16/16 – 12/31/16: Water/Sewer Main replacements on Lark St and Jay St in the Village of Cobleskill (Weather Permitting; 50% completion in 2016).
