HAZARD MITIGATION PRIORITIES

- Consider Hazard Mitigation Goals when setting policies, preparing budgets and making land use decisions
- Review and update local Hazard Mitigation Plan provisions regularly, and at least annually
- Encourage/ promote Flood Insurance (NFIP) participation
- Encourage hazard mitigation measures for Repetitive Loss Properties in flood zones
- Promote citizen awareness and participation in hazard mitigation measures
- Coordinate Hazard Mitigation needs and activities with County Planning and Emergency Management
- Monitor changing vulnerabilities and conditions related to potential hazards

HAZARD MITIGATION GOALS AND PROJECTS

Evaluate 3 residences located in the special flood hazard area to determine if property acquisition, or the elevation and flood-proofing of structures and utilities are warranted



Develop and implement a strategy for replacing undersized bridges and culverts on public roadways and for access to private property. Possible projects include Mill Creek/Porter Road and the following sites that require bridge and culvert replacement

- Mill Creek/Porter Road
- North Harpersfield and Moxley Streets
- North Harpersfield Road
- Clapper Hollow Road at State Land
- Allen Road near Clapper Hollow Road
- West of the Clapper Hollow/Stanard Road Intersection
- At Stannard Road/Clapper Hollow Road Intersection
- Palmer Road
- Merchant Road
- Creamery Street near Fire Department
- Campo Road
- Sternberg Road

Work with the County to identify, create and maintain firebreaks on forested steep slopes near structures. Priority area is the Hamlet of Eminence

Consider creating a riparian buffer zone to protect waterways and reduces flood potential

Mitigate Beaver dams to prevent flooding
