


HAZARD MITIGATION PRIORITIES

- Consider Hazard Mitigation Goals when setting policies, preparing budgets and making land use decisions
- Review and update local Hazard Mitigation Plan provisions regularly, and at least annually
- Encourage/ promote Flood Insurance (NFIP) participation
- Encourage hazard mitigation measures for Repetitive Loss Properties in flood zones
- Promote citizen awareness and participation in hazard mitigation measures
- Coordinate Hazard Mitigation needs and activities with County Planning and Emergency Management
- Monitor changing vulnerabilities and conditions related to potential hazards

HAZARD MITIGATION GOALS AND PROJECTS

- Evaluate 5 residences located in the special flood hazard area to determine if property acquisition, or the elevation and flood-proofing of structures and utilities are warranted
- Study, develop, and implement projects for stabilizing streambanks in locations where erosion threatens development and agriculture
- Secure funding and design project to eliminate existing landslide on Patrick Road
