


## HAZARD MITIGATION PRIORITIES

- Consider Hazard Mitigation Goals when setting policies, preparing budgets and making land use decisions
- Review and update local Hazard Mitigation Plan provisions regularly, and at least annually
- Encourage/ promote Flood Insurance (NFIP) participation
- Encourage hazard mitigation measures for Repetitive Loss Properties in flood zones
- Promote citizen awareness and participation in hazard mitigation measures
- Coordinate Hazard Mitigation needs and activities with County Planning and Emergency Management
- Monitor changing vulnerabilities and conditions related to potential hazards

## HAZARD MITIGATION GOALS AND PROJECTS

- Evaluate and implement measures to protect the village reservoir from impacts associated with a hazardous material incident that could occur on the adjacent I-88 interstate highway
- Implement measures to prevent or mitigate landslides that could affect NYS Route 10
- Implement cooperative measures with the Bear Gulch Lake Homeowners Association to prevent and/or mitigate potential failure of the Bear Gulch Lake Dam in the Town of Summit
