Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the

Village as follows:

Section 1. Village Code §148-7. All-night parking, is hereby repealed and replaced with the following:

§148-7. All-night parking.

- A. The parking of vehicles is hereby prohibited on all highways within the Village between 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. from November 1 to April 15 except as otherwise specifically provided in this chapter.
- B. (Reserved)
- C. The parking of vehicles is hereby prohibited in the cited Village parking lots between 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. from November 1 to April 15 except as otherwise specifically provided in this chapter.

Main and Union Street Lot	Daily	Entire Lot

Section 2. Village Code §148-8. Time limit parking, is hereby repealed and replaced with the following:

§148-8. Time limit parking.

- A. Two-hour parking. No person shall park a vehicle for longer than two hours on the following described Village highways, public parking lots or parts thereof from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday except holidays:

Street/Lot	Side	Hours/Days	Limits
Main and Union Street Lot	Entire Lot	6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday, except holidays	
South Grand Street Lot	Center of lot	6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday Except holidays	

- B. Twenty-minute parking. No person shall park a vehicle for longer than 20 minutes on the following described Village highways, public parking lots or parts thereof from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday, except holidays:

Street/Lot	Side	Limits
Union Street	East	From Lark Street south 152 feet
Union Street	West	From Lark Street south 110 feet
Union Street		13 spaces immediately north of the US Post Office

- C. Free All Day Public Parking. The following parking lots are designated "Free All Day Public Parking" lots as described:

Street/Lot	Hours/Days	Limits
Union Street Lot	All Days	All spaces other than the 13 spaces immediately north of the US Post Office
South Grand Street Lot	All Days	All spaces other than the 12 spaces in the center of the lot
Firehouse Lot	8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday except Holidays	25 spaces at west end of parking lot

Section 3. Village Code §148-23. Parking time limits established, is hereby repealed and replaced with the following:

§148-23. Parking time limits established.

The parking of vehicles is hereby prohibited for a period of longer than two hours between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., Monday through Saturdays, except holidays.

Section 4. Village Code §148-32.C. Parking in Village parking lots during snow emergency. C. Parking lots, is hereby repealed and replaced with the following:

§148-32. Parking in Village parking lots during snow emergency.

C. Parking lots. The following areas are designated as Village parking lots:

- (1) Division Street Parking Lot (TMP#68.06-1-14).
- (2) S. Grand Street Parking Lot (TMP#68.05-5-7).
- (3) Main and Union Street Parking Lot (TMP#56.18-7-21).
- (4) Union Street Parking Lot (TMP#56.17-8-12).
- (5) Firehouse Lot (TMP#68.6-3-6) – Limited to 25 spaces at the west end of the parking lot.

Section 5. This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the office of the New York State Secretary of State.
