To reviewers of the draft Village of Richmondville Zoning Law:

A Village Zoning Rewrite Committee has been working on this draft zoning law since early 2008. Work on the law is not finished, but is at a point where the Committee wants to make sure anyone with suggestions or other input has an opportunity to do so. The Zoning Rewrite Committee is still working on the document including numbering, formatting, and drafting a new Village zoning map with all districts included.

The Zoning Rewrite Committee does not have the authority to adopt a zoning law, but will submit a recommended law to the Village Board for their consideration. The Village Board must hold at least one public hearing and meet other legal requirements before taking final action on the proposed law. There is ample opportunity for public input throughout the process and that opportunity continues.

You can help in this process by letting the Zoning Rewrite Committee know your opinions about the current draft law and your recommended changes and/or additions. Please understand that every individual opinion may not be incorporated in the law, but will be considered.
