### Program Intent

Schoharie Recovery's scarce resources are used primarily in conjunction with volunteer labor to reduce the out-of-pocket cost of repair and reconstruction of homes, non-profit facilities and businesses without flood insurance. While volunteer help will be offered to all to the degree possible, financial assistance is only available for damage that has not and will not be reimbursed through flood insurance or other sources. **All applicants** must certify below that there is **no coverage or reimbursement** for the damage. **Those** who state that repair/reconstruction costs constitute a **serious financial hardship** (such as bankruptcy or lack of credit) may be given **higher priority** if funds are not sufficient to cover all requests.

### Certification of Eligibility (required):

\_\_\_\_ I/we experienced damage to our home, non profit facility or business from the flood caused by Tropical Storm Irene and/or Tropical Storm Lee. The items/materials for which we request financial assistance from Schoharie Recovery are not covered by flood insurance and have not or will not be covered by other reimbursements. I/we are committed to staying for a minimum of one year.

### Certification of Hardship (only if applicable):

\_\_\_\_ I/we are faced with serious financial hardship due to a complete lack of resources (bankruptcy, lack of credit) to repair our home or business.

GUIDANCE REGARDING ELIGIBILITY**

**Location of Damaged Property:**

Schoharie Recovery's financial assistance is targeted to the Village of Schoharie and surrounding areas – properties must be located within the Schoharie School District. Applicants outside but near the boundary of the school district may request consideration as an exception to this rule.

**Eligible Properties:**

Schoharie Recovery's financial assistance is intended to offset losses incurred by the recent flood by helping in the repair and rebuilding process. Properties may be residential, commercial, or non-profit. It is assumed that the applicant is the owner of the property. If the applicant is not the owner, documentation of the owner's knowledge and consent to the repair/reconstruction work must be provided separately.

**Eligible Items and Materials:**

Eligible items and materials are those required for repair or reconstruction of damaged properties. These include: electric service entrance boxes and circuit breakers; wiring and outlets; heating systems; water heaters; permanent lighting; foundations; floor framing, sub-floors and permanent floor covering; insulation, wall framing and wallboard; permanent kitchen or bath cabinets; plumbing fixtures.

**Ineligible Items and Materials:**

Because of limited funding, Schoharie Recovery must exclude those items that tend to be non-permanent. These include: appliances, lighting and other "plug in" fixtures; furniture, wall coverings, area rugs, and the like.

**Note:** Schoharie Recover board of trustee's decision is final.
